In line with the <u>EUPeace mission statement</u>, the objective of this first edition of the Teaching Europe Conference is to develop joint and innovative teaching and learning experiences, to identify innovative teaching practices in all the partner universities, and bring our entire academic communities together to generate knowledge, competence and innovative approaches to fostering peace, justice, and inclusive societies.

Objectives:

- Share best practices, innovative methods to peers and students through the presentations
- Train peers and students to new methods or techniques through the workshops
- Share the values of the project with teachers, trainers and students of the Alliance Universities
- Bring together colleagues and students from various universities and training institutes in Europe
- Create a Europe wide network on innovative training methods and capacity building on inclusion and diversity
- Widen the cooperation to education/training programmes and offer the possibility to cooperate through national or European funding (Erasmus programme, etc.)

Topics for papers include (but not limited to):

- Teaching "Peace ", "Justice ", and "Inclusion "
- Themes of inclusion and diversity in a European context (and beyond);
- Fostering intercultural knowledge and competences in school and university education;
- Multilingualism in the class- and seminar room: challenges and opportunities
